

# Toddler Lesson Plan

**Activity:** Playdough - Multiple colors ( Leanne aged 3 )

<b>Week 1</b>	<b>Comments/observations:</b> <i>Leanne chooses the blue playdough. Then begins to roll it. Then she chooses the red and starts to mix these together into a ball.</i>
<b>Week 2</b>	<b>Comments/Observations:</b> <i>Now added another color (yellow) and some tools. Leanne starts to roll the playdough choosing yellow. She now uses the shape cutters and smiles as she has made a star shape.</i>
<b>Week 3</b>	<b>Comments/Observations:</b> <i>Added more shapes and small cutters. Leanne smiles and begins to roll the mixed colors of playdough. She repeats the names of the colors and holds a small cutter. She says "look making dinner"</i>
<b>Week 4</b>	<b>Comments/Observations:</b> <i>Add play plates, cutters and roller. Leanne starts to cut small pieces of playdough. Then starts rolling small pieces. She laughs saying "making peas". Leanne asks for green playdough saying "peas are</i>

## Summary:

*Leanne clearly enjoys playing with the playdough. Knowing her colors and asking for more colors. Leanne uses her imagination and found making food from the playdough fun. Leanne is learning to handle the tools with confidence. She is also using a lot of language to describe what she is doing.*
