

# Toddler Lesson Plan

**Activity:** Playdough

(Josh aged 4)

<b>Week 1</b>	<b>Comments/observations:</b> <i>Josh wanders to the cupboard choosing the playdough. He picks up the red, green and blue. Josh says "going to make some animals. He now rolls the green playdough and says "this is my big snake". He uses his hands as well.</i>
<b>Week 2</b>	<b>Comments/Observations:</b> <i>Added some plastic animals (dinosaurs). Josh uses the blue playdough. Then looking at the dinosaurs he says "I'm going to make it a den". Josh then rolls it out wide and thin. Then covers the dinosaur .</i>
<b>Week 3</b>	<b>Comments/Observations:</b> <i>Josh continues with animals. Josh mixes the red and yellow using his hands. He rolls this into a ball. He then rolls the green and blue together He then places the balls on top of each other. Josh then pushes his finger in to make eyes.</i>
<b>Week 4</b>	<b>Comments/Observations:</b> <i>Josh looks at the picture of of a tiger and says "I am going to make a big tiger" as he now starts to roll and cut the playdough. Placing various pieces to make his tiger.</i>

## Summary:

*Josh loves playdough and has used this to produce various animals. He loves doing this and talks about it. He uses the playdough to be imaginative and incorporated the play animals into many of his games. Josh is excellent at his colors and found mixing the colors of great interest. He can now handle the tools and equipment well.*
